- All competitors are required to have a Manitoba Horse Council or other Provincial Horse Council/Federation membership for insurance protection. Signed WAIVER MUST BE HANDED IN PRIOR TO SHOW.
- Anyone who competes in CWA show automatically becomes a part of the CWA. There are no membership fees. Points collected for horse/rider combo at each of the 4 shows will be used for year-end high point awards.
- Entries will be accepted by email to [lighthouse@dufferinagsociety.com](mailto:lighthouse@dufferinagsociety.com). Registration form and signed waver are required for entry. Pre-registration is preferred. Entries are accepted at show and throughout the show day.
- Tie stalls and limited number of box stalls are available on a first-come-first-serve basis. Tack stall provided upon request free of charge. Please reserve at registration via email. Stalls must be cleaned prior to departure.
- One entry form & registration fee per Exhibitor/Rider, per show. Show is NERIC approved; proper spelling of horses registered name is required on entry form.
- Full payment must be made by cash or check at fair office or show secretary prior to show start. Cash payment is required to add classes after show starts.
- Payout is 1st \$20, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10, 4th \$5. Classes will be placed to 10<sup>th</sup> place for year-end awards.
- Show office opens 1 hour before scheduled show start time. Changes to classes are permitted on show day. Can also add classes on show day but must bring cash to pay.
- Proper show attire/footwear is required. Half chaps and paddock boots accepted for English. Long sleeve shirts required for all western and speed events. All exhibitors under 18 years of age are required to wear an approved riding helmet.
- Clean up manure behind your horses on grounds, grass and in barns.
- The exhibitor number you are given will be with you for the entire season when participating at CWA Shows. Duplicate number cards will be given.
- Exhibitor number MUST be visible to be judged. Note that in Showmanship, number must be on your back. While riding, number should be on each side of your saddle pad.
- A horse may be shown twice in trail and speed events. However, a horse can only show ONCE in all other classes. i.e., said horse can be shown in junior horsemanship and senior horsemanship, but NOT twice in Jr Horsemanship.
- Classes with 3 or less entries will be combined with another age category where possible.
- No exhibitor cross entry with the Walk/Jog classes into the regular classes, except in speed events, regardless of horse. For example, a rider can NOT show horse A in Trail and horse B in walk/jog trail.
- Horses competing in Walk/Jog classes may be ridden two hands in a snaffle or 1 handed in a shank bit, regardless of age. Horses 6 years and older must be shown one-handed in shank bit; English classes and speed events exempt.
- Walk/jog competitors are permitted to lope in speed events (barrels, pole bending, key hole).
- If young riders require assistance in the arena with someone near them, other than in lead line, they can compete however they will be placed below any competitors able to exhibit on their own without assistance.
- Unprofessional behaviour including foul language, bullying, cruel or inhumane treatment of animals will not be tolerated. Party will be asked to leave the grounds; no refund given.
- By participating in CWA events, all competitors agree to abide by the rules of the show and the governing body AQHA.
- No refunds unless a Dr. / Vet note for exhibitor or horse is provided.
- Judges' decision is final. The CWA reserves the right to interpret these rules and regulations. All decisions by the CWA board will be final. By way of making an entry, the exhibitor is assuming responsibility for knowledge of the rules and releases show management from any claims or losses.
